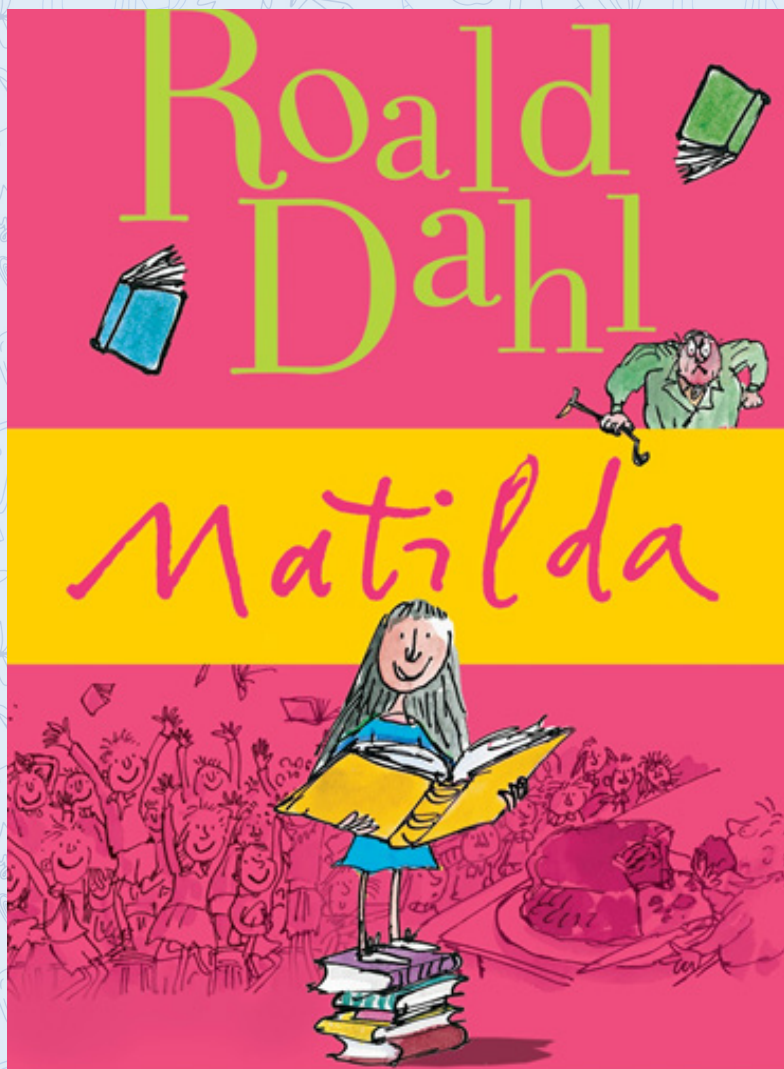

It is fun to play in with toys. You can pretend you are on an adventure in your own room!

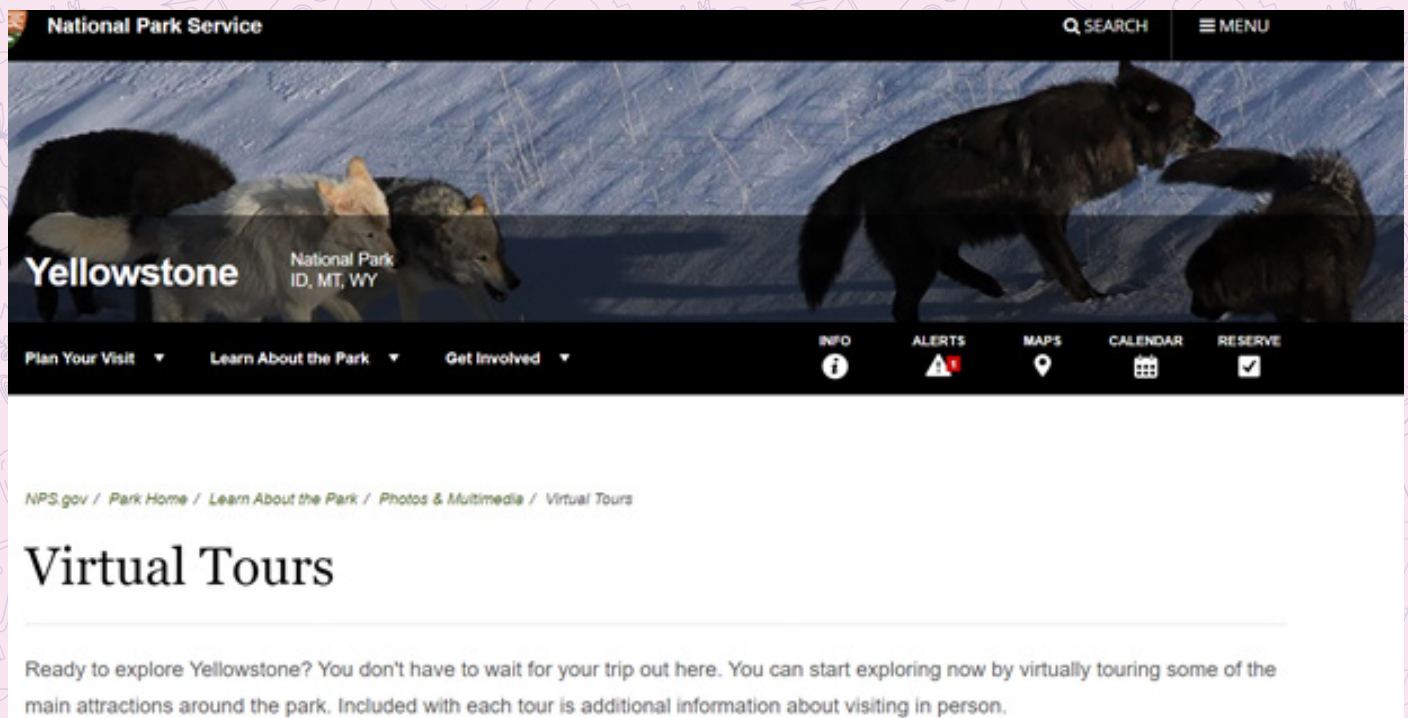


Go on a field trip, but from home!

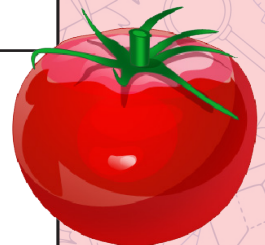

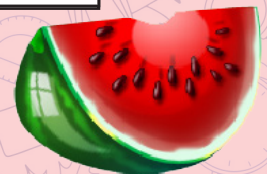
