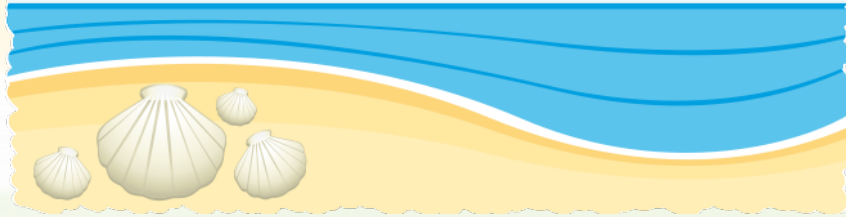

《閱讀課外書的好處》

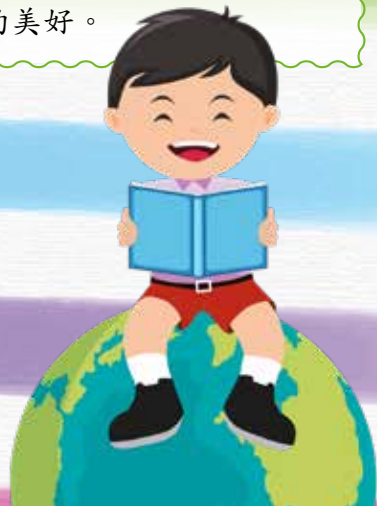

Hello everyone! I'm Lucy. I've travelled outside Hong Kong three times and the most unforgettable one was the trip to Thailand. Let me tell you about it.

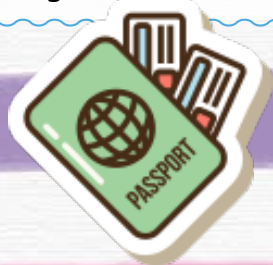
Last year, I travelled to Thailand with my family. We did a lot of things there. We visited some temples, ate Thai food, did some water sports and fed a baby tiger too.

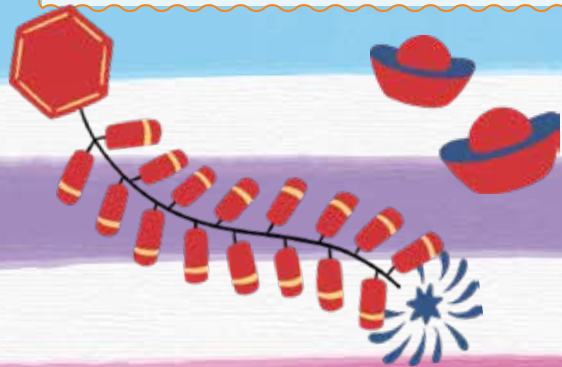
When and where is Chinese New Year celebrated?

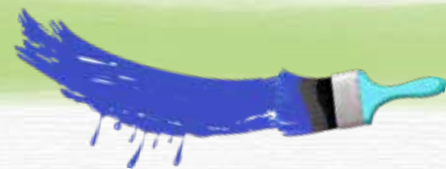






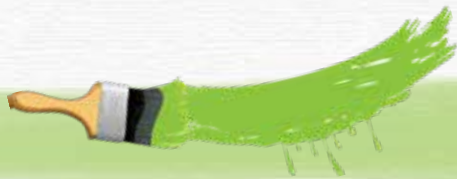
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
